2.2 Presentation of 10/24/2023 CCAL Financial Report

3.1 Officials Assignors Update: (Info) Officials Assignor Mark Chase

David Sanchez shared out the information from the Manager meeting.

3.3 2023/24 SJS Model Coach Award Nominations: (Info) Com. Felt

Explained the process for selecting the model coach award.

Ed explained that Enoch has recommended a model coach award. Justin explained that Niles is an excellent coach that is always willing to jump in.

Nominations are due by November 6. We currently do not have a female nomination. The application requires that the coach who is being nominated complete much of the nomination form.

3.4 Triple Round Robin Schedules for 2024/25 & 2025/26: (Info) Com. Felt

Almost all team sports outside of football have been playing a double Round-Robin Schedule. A Triple Round Robin schedule has fifteen games. Ed explained that in a Triple Round Robin schedule we will not have to use any form of tie breaking because each team will play three times. The current Double Round-Robin Schedule causes ties and results in problems. This new model eliminates tie-breakers. Justin explained that he appreciates the new rule so that we don't have to scramble to organize a tie-breaker game.

David Sanchez asked if this new system will impact the cost with regards to transportation and officials.

Jimmy stated that historically in Modesto City Schools the district provided funding for in-league games. This change in policy should actually result in a cost savings.

He stated that there is a scenario for a tie breaker, but that is very rare compared to right now.

Jimmy stated that the biggest challenge is trying to fit fifteen games in for winter sport and the holidays.

Ed stated that the only way to not impact Winter Break, we will need to start two weeks before Winter Break.

No other questions or concerns. Ed stated that whatever we decide will be the rule.

Donnie explained that when it comes to tie-breakers this year, it is important that the AD's attend these meetings with the coaches. This is outlined in our bylaws.

Justin explained that if AD's are having any problems with the coaches, the coaches are available to support AD's.

3.5 Girls Flag Football Update: (Info) Com. Felt

James has been working to lead the work with the implementation of Flag Football.

Girls have a 28-game contest next year, with 15 in league games. We are hoping to play Monday and Wednesdays every week.

Dustin explained that they were trying to match up the schedule with girls tennis.

Mike said that the team in the CC love flag football.

David Sanchez asked if teams using have one, two, or three levels. Most schools have two right now.

3.6 Three Levels of Soccer Teams Update: (Info) CCAL Principals

The three levels of soccer are still in the negotiations process. MCS is still waiting on the new contract.

Phil asked if the stipend is approved, can we still table the decision to add a third level?

Phil stated that he would love to see three levels, but practice space needs to be accounted for. Before we move forward with this plan, we need to ensure we discuss all of the logistics.

Modesto City Schools is currently discussing adding another varsity assist coach and a freshman level coach.
