2.2 Presentation of August 19, 2020 CCAL Financial Report

(F&M Bank Statements (5/1/20-8/2/20) Ed reviewed the financial report from 5/1/2020 – 6/30/2020; we started the month of May with \$8,778.02 and ended at the end of June with \$2,130.75. Two checks still need to be deposited, one for \$700.00 and another for \$2,200 from Turlock High School. Ed stated that he anticipates that our first bill this year will be for playoff fees. CIF is revised their budget when it didn't pass the first time; they reverted back to their old budget for playoff fees. Ed stated that if we could send our fees to him as soon as possible that would be great. Motion was made by Jason Manning to approve the financial statement; second made by Gabe Ontiveros; Motion approved 6-0.

There may be some issues with playoffs on graduations dates as well. There are not any contests scheduled during finals’ week for both Districts. Ed will send the schedule/sheet that could show possible conflicts for us to communicate to our districts.

Ed reviewed contest start times for both Season One and Two. If we have an athlete who is good enough for playing both sports we’d like to look at different dates to have some possible alternate start times; info will be shared at the September meeting. All principals were fine with this idea and being flexible with these dates.
