2.0 Old Business: Commissioner Felt

2.1 Presentation of November 17, 2020 CCAL Leadership Team Minutes –Ed presented the minutes from 11/17/20 meeting; Derek made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Jason; all 6 sites approved the minutes.

2.2 Presentation of December 15, 2020 CCAL Financial Report (F&M Bank Statement and CCAL Activities (11/2-11/30/20) - Ed reviewed the financial report for the month of November; we started the month with \$14,305.75; no debits and no credits; new balance is \$14,305.75. Motion to approve the financial report by Jason, seconded by Gabe Ontiveros; all 6 sites approved the financial report.

3.0 New Business: Commissioner Felt

3.1 Officials Assignor Update: Mark Chase – Mark stated that we now have new guidelines that are out from the state regarding athletics. Mark stated that if we have games on our schedules and need to cancel games that we can; change the date, or email Brian or Mark and they will delete them.

Ed stated that if we have our seasons pushed back like they have been but we could start season 1 in February then we discussed increasing games to be played on Saturdays to increase contacts in water polo and volleyball.

3.2 Season One - Updates and Plans for Possible Disruptions: Felt – The new document from the state states that everything is on hold until January 4<sup>th</sup> when there will be a new release from the state; don't plan on any games until at least January 25<sup>th</sup>. Review the State Guidance on Outdoor/Indoor Youth and Recreational Adult Sports. It was asked if there has been any discussion about switching seasons? Dave stated that there has not; just maintain present calendar with the adjustments from public health. Mark stated at the league commissioners meeting last week, they didn't have the state document; now that we have the document the conversations will probably shift with what we can/can't do as far as planning goes. Dave stated that they did talk about the availability of counties being able to start prior to others. Ed stated that priority is to save the spring sports because they were cut short from last year. The state has offered to eliminate any state and regional playoff dates. Any post play would be for San Joaquin Section Championships. 90% commissioners felt it was more important for kids to play preseason and league games than in the playoff games. Section Office did share that as a league if we don't want to play in playoffs this year then there will not be any penalties this year. Ed stated that he'd like to propose that will just wait until our meeting in January.
