2.0 Old Business: Commissioner Felt

2.1 Presentation of September 30, 2021 CCAL Leadership Team Minutes – Ed reviewed the minutes; motion to accept the minutes by Jason, second by Derek. All six sites approved the minutes.

2.2 Presentation of October 28, 2021 CCAL Financial Report (F&M Bank Statement and CCAL Activities (9/1-9/30/21). Ed reviewed the financial statement. Starting balance was \$7,764.69; there was a debit of \$80.00 to the Modesto Police Department for “Parade and Sound” permits required for the two CCAL cross country meets held at the Tuolumne Regional Park. There was a credit amount of \$4400.00 for two more CCAL Assessment Fees checks deposited. The ending balance is \$12,084.69. Motion made to

approve the financial report made by Amanda; second by Derek; all six sites approved the report.

3.0 New Business: Commissioner Felt

3.1 MCS & TUSD Basketball Mask Protocols: Ed stated that there is no update to the mask rule in basketball.

3.2 Officials Assignor Update: Bryan Moore reported that sports' schedules need to be entered before Friday; it closes Friday. If we need support for entering Mark/Bryan will support. Bryan thanked the group for the new payments this year. Bryan stated that officials are low; banners and posters will be dropped off at each school to advertise the need for officials; place on the field, gym, locker rooms, etc. Typically there are 225 officials per year; currently there are 120. There may on how officials are sent to games; there may not be officials for freshman games and have the officials officiate a double header for JV and Varsity. Officials will not be the mask police; it is the responsibility of the site if athletes/coaches are not wearing masks.

3.3 Oct. 6th SJS BOM Meeting News: President Freeman – a discussion was had about the section office and approval from Board of Managers for the section office to do some research on finding comparables for the value of the section office. The league agreed that the section should hold a special/emergency meeting if information is collected on the potential sell of the section office and purchase of a new location.

3:4 2022/23 Contest Start Times/ Later School Start Times: Com. Felt discussed the start time for next school year that will affect start times for sports and transportation.

3.5 CCAL Model Coach Award Nominations: President Freeman – Freeman stated that they are due tomorrow; just send through email.

3.6 Other Time Sensitive Topics/Issues – Walls stated that he sent an email out to track coaches for quad meet and dual meet; if you can remind coaches to respond to Dave's email.

3.6.1 Bryan Moore discusses that for the 2022-2023 school year the 35 second shot clock may be instated for both boys and girls; he asked if our league cared if we change it. The league stated they are fine with setting the shot clock 35 seconds for both boys and girls.
